About the Collateral Event

Greenhouse Garden: Reflect, Project, Connect in Serra dei Giardini is a Swedish event consisting of an exhibition, a temporary wooden pavilion, by In Praise of Shadows architects, and a series of seminars and workshops on architecture, the built environment and the global goals of Agenda 2030, as well as how architecture and wood can be part of it.

Plots, Prints, Projections is the title of the exhibition at Serra dei Giardini. It will house a series of large scale spatial installations that are the result of an investigation of the contemporary and challenged role of architectural representations and their translations to built form, in the meeting with the dynamic material wood and the manufacturing industry. This will entail architectural explorations of the transitions from architectural drawings, measuring's, notations and virtual instructions for production to their material manifestation using wood as a primary material, and vice versa. Embedded in history of architectural practice, different digital and analogue modes of architectural representation continue to be techniques for understanding and investigating the discipline of architecture.

Greenhouse Garden: Reflect, Project, Connect, alla Serra dei Giardini, è un progetto svedese composto da un'esposizione, un padiglione temporaneo in legno progettato dagli architetti In Praise of Shadows, una serie di seminari e workshop sull'architettura, l'ambiente costruito, sugli obiettivi globali dell'Agenda 2030 e su come l'architettura e il legno possano contribuirvi.

Plots, Prints, Projections è il titolo della mostra alla Serra dei Giardini, che ospiterà una serie di installazioni di grande formato, risultato di un'indagine sul ruolo attuale dell'architettura e delle rappresentazioni architettoniche e delle loro traduzioni in forme costruite, incrociando il potenziale di un materiale dinamico come il legno con l'industria manifatturiera. Il progetto è un'esplorazione sulla transizione tra i disegni architettonici, le notazioni di misura, le istruzioni virtuali per la produzione e le loro manifestazioni materiali, con il legno come materiale primario. Inseriti nel contesto della storia della pratica architettonica, diversi modi di rappresentazione, digitali e analogici, continuano a costituire delle tecniche fondamentali per comprendere e sperimentare l'architettura.
